A placed in annual assessment of Program Level Student Learning Outcomes will be utilized

- **Fall, 2017** – All programs establish (or re-establish) PLSLOs (entered in Improve)\*\* **JAN 15<sup>th</sup> (now March 31)**
- **Spring, 2018** – All programs develop their plan for assessing outcomes\*\* **JUNE 15<sup>th</sup>**
- **Fall, 2018** – All programs begin to collect data based on their plan
- **Spring, 2019** – Programs use data to make improvements:

### Developing Program-Level Student Learning Outcomes (PLSLO)

- Program Level Student Learning Outcomes are statements that specify what students **will know, be able to do or be able to demonstrate** when they have completed a program of study. (Any organized program of study that results in a credential)
- Outcomes are expressed as knowledge, skills, attitudes or values.
- Program Level SLOs should address both what the program faculty identify as critical skills, attitudes, values, etc. and what the industry expects of entry-level professionals.
