Instructions: This form applies to travel with university-owned laptops, smart phones and other electronic media storage. Review, complete, and sign this letter. Carry one copy with luggage to present to Customs if requested or in the event of a search. Return a copy to the International Travel Office, B25 Clark Hall.

Background: The export of items, technology, commercial software, and encryption code is subject to federal export control regulations (this includes laptops, smart phones and digital storage devices). The Department of Commerce Export Administration Regulations (EAR) makes an exception to licensing requirements for the temporary export or reexport of certain items, technology, or software for professional use as long as the criteria to which you are certifying below are met. The exception does not apply to any EAR satellite or space-related equipment, components, or software, or to any technology associated with high-level encryption products. In addition, this exception does not apply to items, technology, data, or software regulated by the International Traffic in Arms Regulations (ITAR).
