

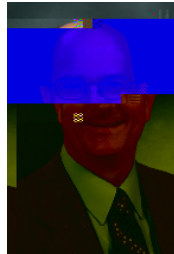

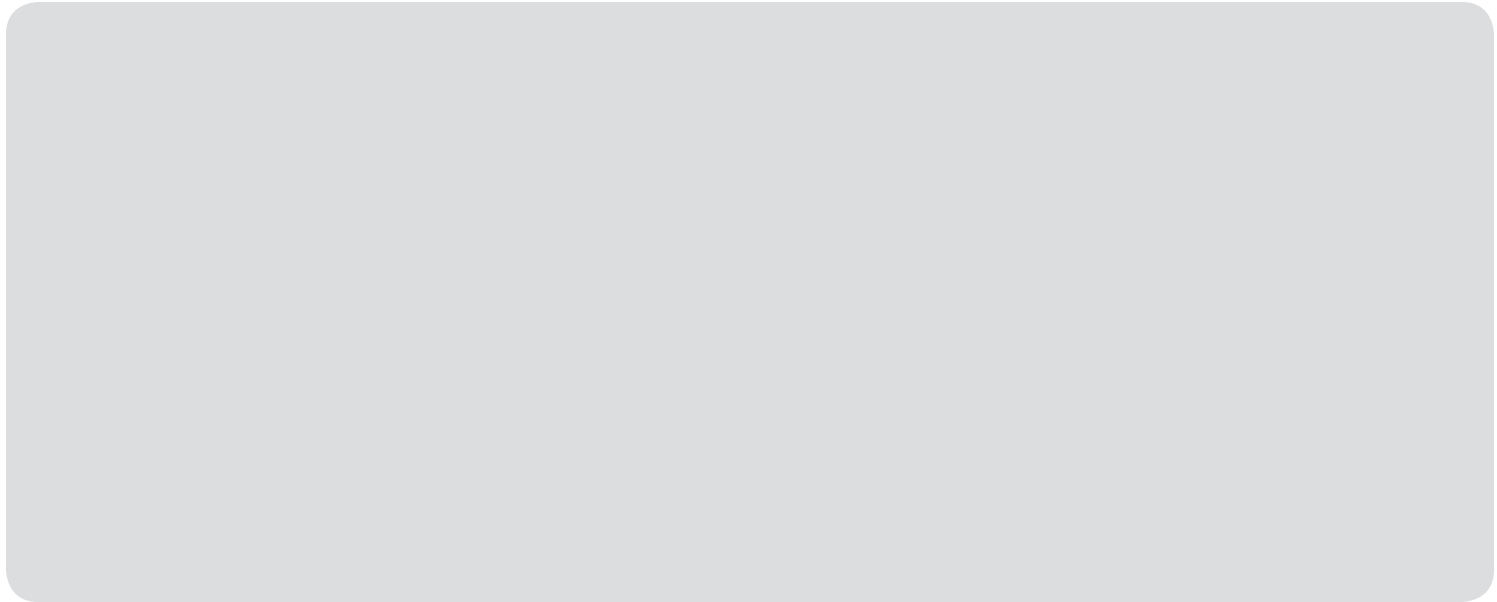

The MA in TESOL (Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages) welcomes prospective TESOL professionals

from around the world. The program is designed to provide students with the knowledge and skills necessary to become effective ESL/EFL teachers in a variety of educational settings.

The program consists of 36 credits of coursework in TESOL, including a major TESOL area of specialization including Methodology, Materials Design, Second Language Acquisition, Second Language Teaching, Language and Society. Along with classroom instruction, students gain practical experience in real-world contexts through a Practicum and Internship in ESL.

The program is designed to be flexible, allowing students to complete their degree in 1.5 to 2 years. The program is also designed to be interdisciplinary, drawing on research and theory from linguistics, psychology, and education.
