Program Level Exams Appeal Policy

Appeals for Program Level Exams such as comprehensive, or qualifying examinations, are made to the Dean of the School of Graduate Studies and Research (SGSR) based on policy and/or procedural violations. The appeal can be based only on policy and/or procedural violations; and not simply on the examination. Procedural violations would be cases in which the program /department failed to follow program/department and/or University policies and/or procedures relating to the administration and/or evaluation of the exam.

The appeal ~~is~~ made in writing to the Dean of the School of Graduate Studies and Research. Documentation of the policy(ies)/procedures in question must be provided, along with a detailed description of the alleged violations(s). All evidence supporting the alleged violation should also be provided. The student must submit the written appeal to the Dean of the SGSR ~~within~~ ^{within} 5 days of receipt of the outcome of the examination.

Upon receipt of the written appeal to the Dean of the SGSR, the Dean will conduct an investigation of the allegation, review the documentation and render a final decision *which completes the appeal process. The final decision rendered by the Dean of the SGSR may not be appealed.*

If it is found that policy/and/or procedure has been violated, the SGSR will instruct the program/department to allow the student to retake the exam, fully adhering to policy and procedures. In the event of a finding in support of the student

allegation, the reexamination may not be counted as a separate attempt

A student dismissed from a program for degree expiration (see Time Limitations policy) can appeal the decision to the Dean of the School of Graduate Studies and Research (SGSR), based on policy and/or procedural violations. The appeal can be based only on policy/procedural vi

The appeal must be made in writing to the Dean of the School of Graduate Studies and Research. Documentation of the policy(ies) in question must be provided, along with a detailed description of the alleged violation(s). All evidence supporting the alleged violation should also be provided. The student must submit the written appeal to the Dean of the SGSR *in 30 days* of receipt of the dismissal letter.

Upon receipt of the written appeal to the Dean of the SGSR will conduct an investigation of the allegation, review the documentation and render a final decision *which completes the appeal process. The final decision rendered by the Dean of the SGSR may not be appealed.*

If it is found that policy/and/or procedure has been violated, SGSR Dean o will rescind the dismissal.
