III. CoChairs Report

- x Ron Freda from Physics was introduced as an observer was just elected to the Committee for 2014-15.
- x GEOS 102 and 106 need to have the prerequisite line changed to match the layout of 104. Since the courses may be taken as corequisites with GEOS 101 and 105 or in a subsequent semester. The catalog descriptions approved by Senate in Feb. 2013 incorrectly listed only a corequisite requirement of the accompanying lecture section instead of a corequisite OR previous enrollment in the accompanying lecture section. The department is quickly going to prepare a proposal so that this can be approved at the April Senate meeting.

- x In preparing the Senate agenda, it was discovered that the CSE 315 (approved 08/04) was also a catalog description change
- x Mocek and Sechrist meet Monday to discuss Certificates. Several faculty members have recently made inquiries. The BOG no longer has to preapprove them. They are classified as Post Bac because a student must have a BA in order to receive a certificate the student can be enrolled in a BA and a certificate at the same time or they may acquire it after receiving a BA. Proposers will need to distinguish how the certificate will benefit the student postgraduation. There must be some upper and lower division courses. Will want to put in this information in the handbook early in the fall.
