EC 346 International Economics II

1 to 3 sh

Prerequisite: EC 345 or permission of instructor

Application of theory of international trade to empirical data and problems; historical survey and examination of current problems of international trade; the institutional setting of international trade.

Description of Proposed Change:

This is currently a three-credit course. We propose making it a one-to-three credit course.

If offered as a one-credit (two-credit) course, the instructor will meet the class one-third (two-thirds) of the normal hours and present about one-third (two-thirds) of the normal material. Since some subjects normally covered in this course might be of more current importance than others, the instructor will have the option to determine which subset of topics will be covered in a particular semester. If an instructor wants to offer the course on a one or two-credit basis, the Department Curriculum Committee will review the proposal.
