

Curriculum Proposal

Curriculum Review Committee

1. The curriculum review committee shall be composed of representatives from the following groups: (a) Teachers; (b) Parents; (c) Community members; (d) Administrators; (e) Students; (f) Other interested parties.

2. The committee shall meet regularly to discuss and recommend curriculum changes to the school board.

3. The committee shall have the authority to recommend the adoption, revision, or deletion of courses of study.

4. The committee shall submit an annual report to the school board on the progress of its work.

5. The committee shall be responsible for ensuring that the curriculum is relevant, up-to-date, and meets the needs of the community.

6. The committee shall also be responsible for monitoring the implementation of the curriculum and making adjustments as needed.

7. The committee shall have the authority to request additional resources or support from the school board.

8. The committee shall be responsible for maintaining communication with the community and other stakeholders.

9. The committee shall have the authority to recommend the appointment or removal of members.

10. The committee shall be responsible for ensuring that the curriculum is aligned with state and national standards.

11. The committee shall have the authority to recommend the adoption of new textbooks or materials.

12. The committee shall be responsible for ensuring that the curriculum is culturally responsive and inclusive.

13. The committee shall have the authority to recommend the adoption of new assessment methods.

14. The committee shall be responsible for ensuring that the curriculum is accessible to all students.

15. The committee shall have the authority to recommend the adoption of new educational technologies.
