### For All Agencies or If You Aren't Certain What Kind of Help You Need

- x ICCAP (Indiana County Community Action Project) Located at 827 Water Street, Phone: 724-465-2657. Provides emergency food boxes at Water Street; you receive monthly food distribution in the community.
- x Salvation Army Located at 635 Water Street, Phone: 724-465-2530. Provides emergency food
- x Indiana County Medical Assistance Office: Located at 2750 W. Pike Road, Phone: 724-465-2657. Can apply for SNAP (formerly called food stamps) by completing an online Compass Application ([www.compass.state.pa.us](http://www.compass.state.pa.us)). You must either be working 20 hours or more per week or have a Federal Work Study job working any amount of hours to qualify.

Open 8:00 am to 4:30 pm Monday through Thursday, and 10:00 am to 4:30 pm on Friday. There are no walk-in hours. Please call to schedule an appointment to be seen.

Provides assessment and referral for drug and alcohol treatment, including inpatient drug and alcohol treatment. Can locate treatment centers, arrange for admission and transportation to and from treatment centers, and pay for the cost of treatment for those who don't have insurance or can't afford their copay and/or deductible.
