

, in December 2014, IUP submitted a pricing flexibility pilot proposal to the Office of the Chancellor that requested a per-credit tuition rate for undergraduate resident students;

, the per-credit tuition pilot, as implemented, assesses undergraduate resident students at a per-credit tuition rate; the tuition charges are calculated based on the number of credits in which the students are enrolled and on the undergraduate resident per-credit rate as approved by the Board of Governors (BOG) and then discounted; and the discount percentages were 7 percent, 4 percent, and 1 percent over three years, with the 1 percent discount continuing thereafter;

, this pilot was approved by the BOG in January 2015, with a revised effective period of fall 2016 through summer 2019, and, in May 2019, IUP provided a pilot report that recommended continuing the pilot;
