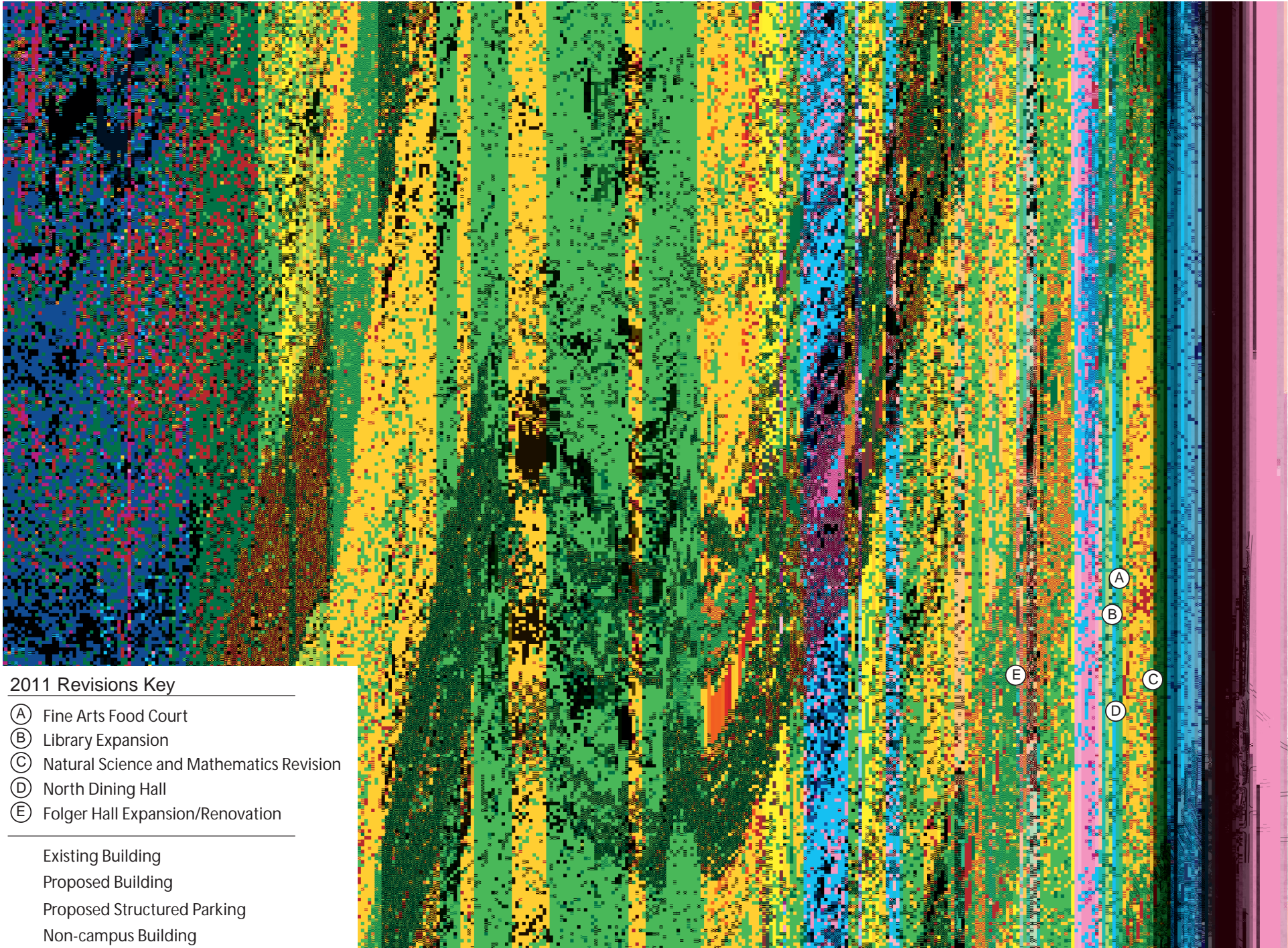

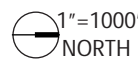

A VISION FOR THE FUTURE

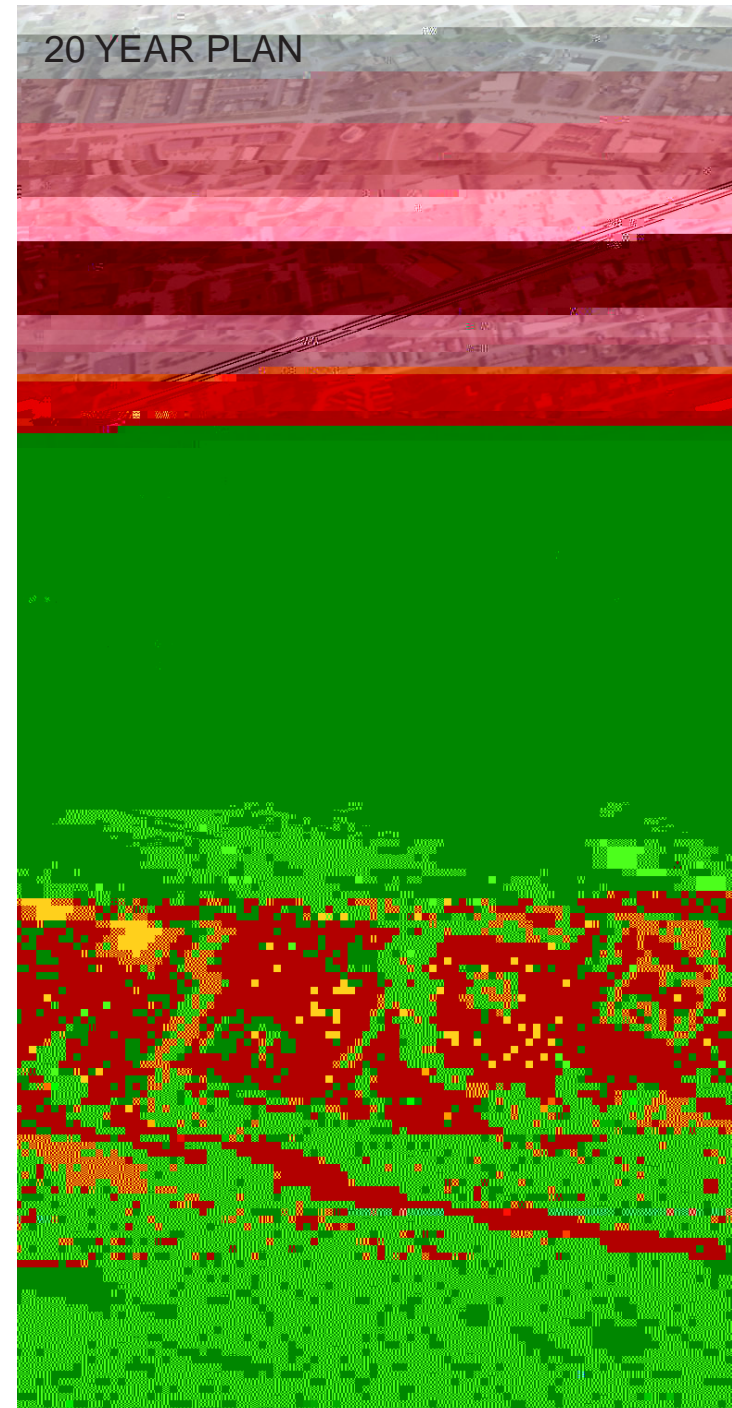
With inclusion of the 2011 revisions to the master plan, the vision still provides a solid framework from which IUP can continue to attract and retain top students, faculty, and staff.

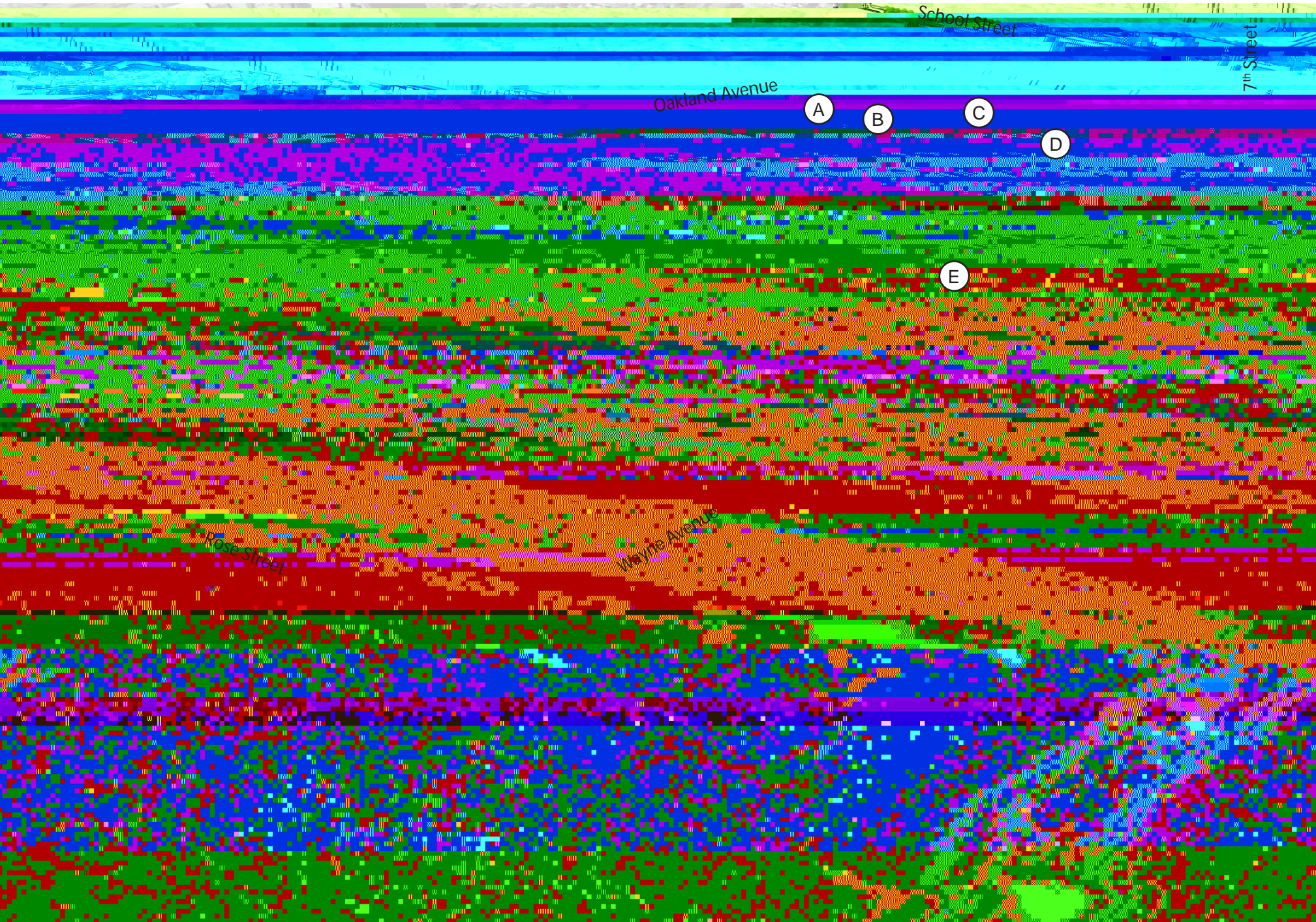
Specific elements revised for 2011 are in-line with strategic goals for the campus established early in the planning process with consensus from various master plan committees.

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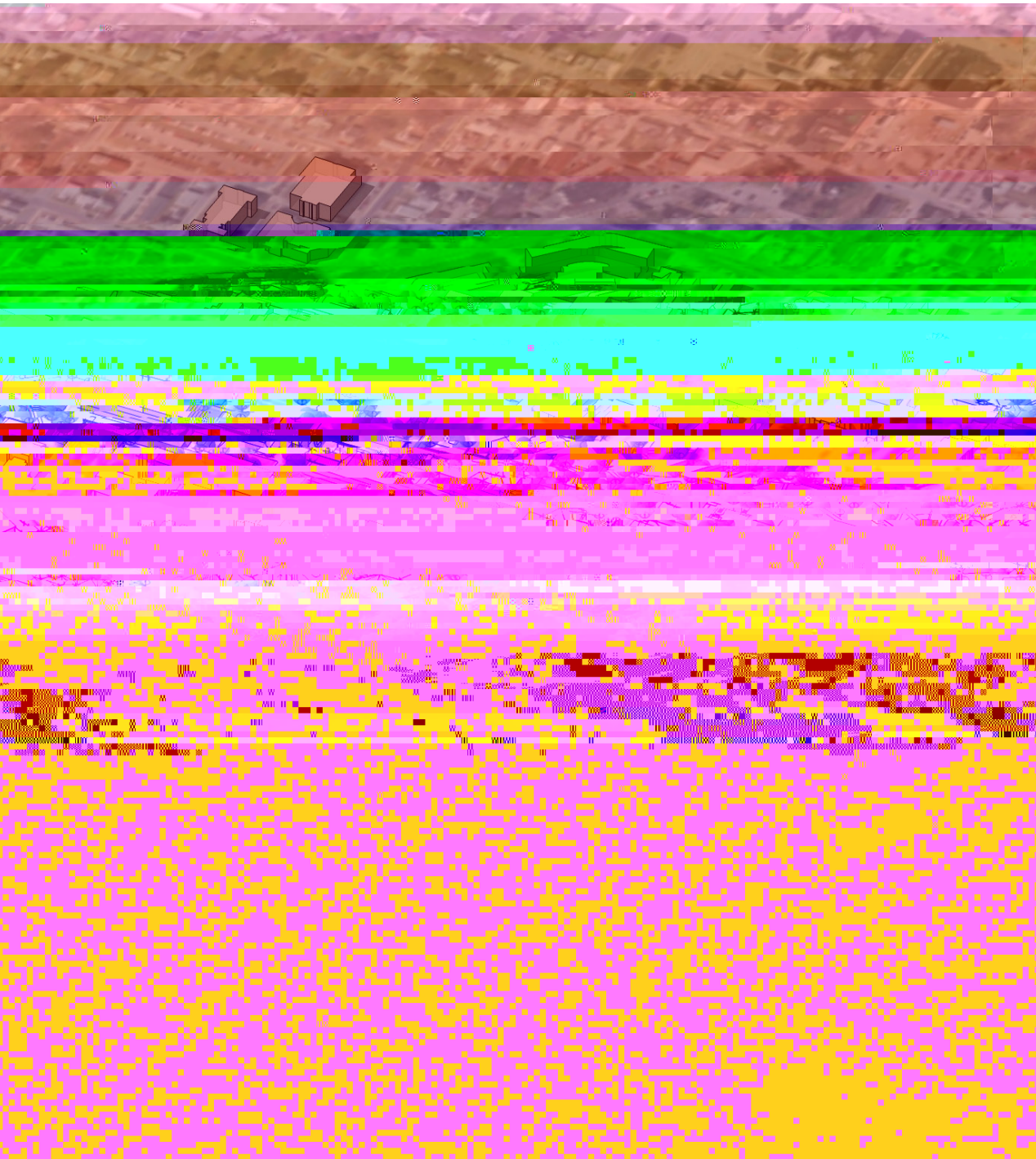




0-5 YEAR PHASING
