Requires routine “**strategic review**” every year and a **comprehensive review** every 5 years

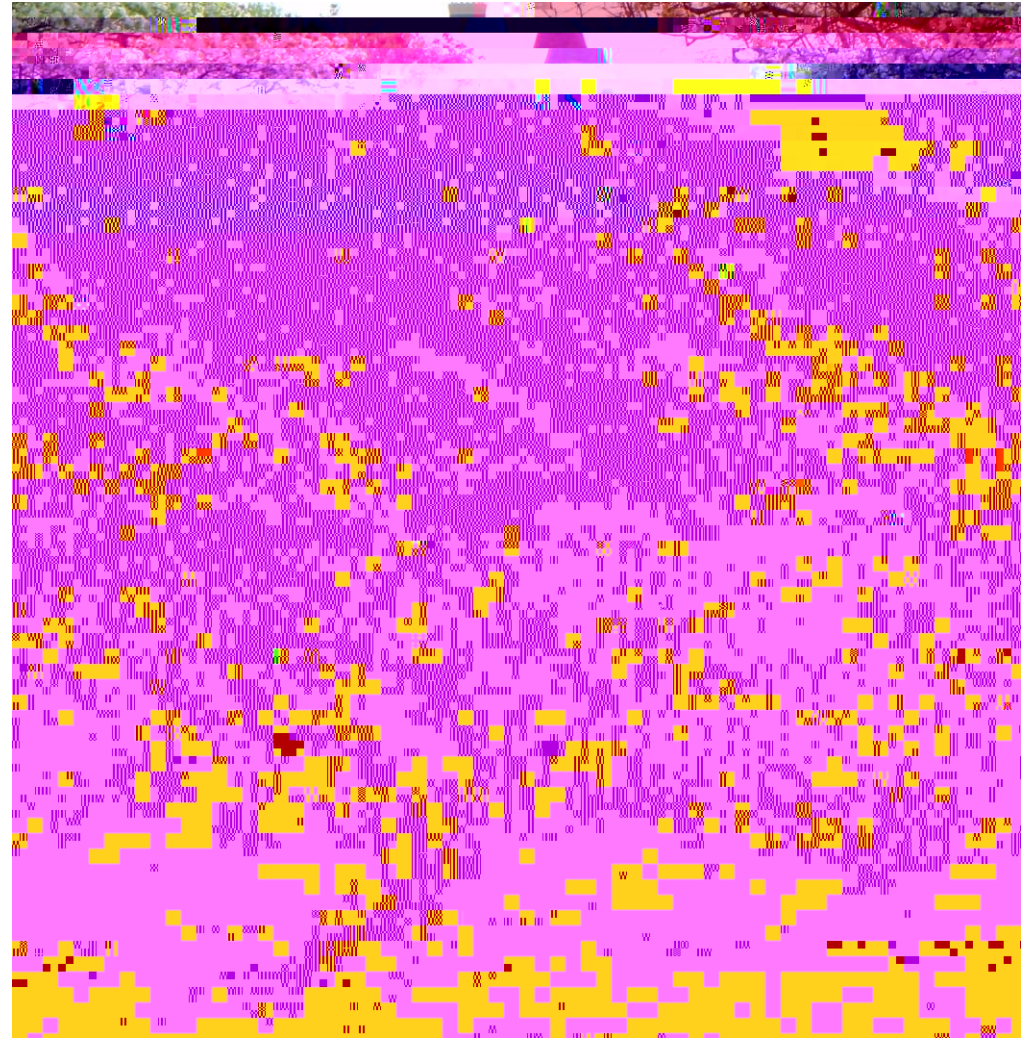
Outlines parameters to strategically manage and phase development opportunities and

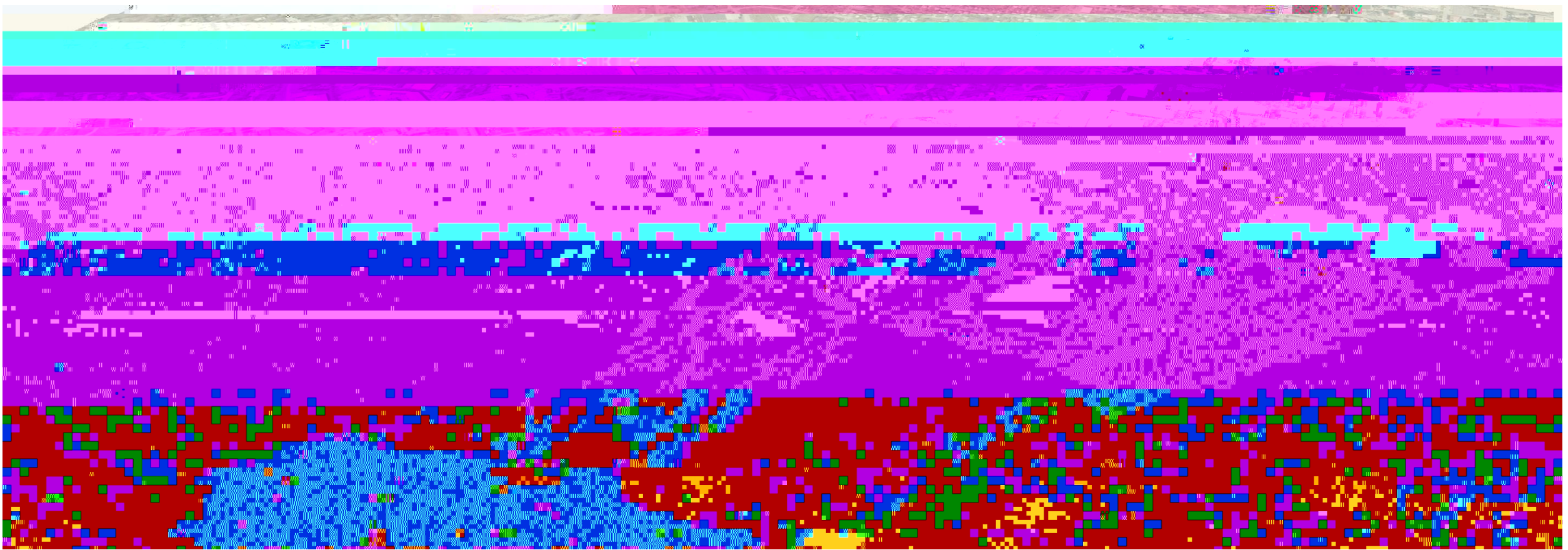
